**A.) Wednesday, August 9, 2017, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.**

***Immigration/Refugees: Historical to present day issues in both the United States and abroad.***  
Presenters include Damien Murray (Elms College), Michael Butler (Clark University), and Michelle LeBlanc (Norman B. Leventhal Map Museum, Boston Public Library). Includes teacher resources and lessons. Lunch provided. Open to all levels. Registration fee: \$25.

**B.) Monday, August 14, 2017, 9 a.m.-12noon.**

***National Geographic Teacher Certification Program***  
Presenter is Kathy Babini (Curriculum Director, Plymouth Public Schools), a National Geographic Certification Program leader. Teachers will be introduced to the Certification program and start the process during the session. Open to all levels. Refreshments provided. Registration fee: \$15.

**C.) Tuesday, August 15, 2017, 9 a.m. - 12noon.**

***Giant MA State Floor Map Licensing Workshop***  
This session will present the *National Geographic Giant MA State Floor Map* with lessons for teachers to use in the classroom. Teachers who complete the session will be licensed to use it and have free use of the giant floor map for one full week in their school. Appropriate for grades K-5. Refreshments provided. Registration fee: \$15.

**D.) Wednesday, August 16, 2017, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m.**

***Engaging Students in International Issues: The Choices Approach***  
This is an introductory program presented by Maureen Stephens (Brown University), Choices Program. Two units will be provided per registrant (\$80 value): *Westward Expansion: A New History* and *Immigration and the U.S. Policy Debate*. Materials are appropriate for grades 7-12. Includes lunch. Registration fee: \$145. (First 10 teachers to register will pay only \$75.)
